Essay Requirements:

- ▶ Youth members will write an essay on a topic assigned for each age category.
- ▶ An essay form must be included as the cover page. See below.
- ▶ Essays must be typed, Size 12 – Times New Roman font, double spaced, 1” margins
- ▶ Length:
 - ▶ Juniors – 1-2 pages
 - ▶ Intermediate – 2-3 pages
 - ▶ Senior – 2-4 pages
- ▶ Essays to be submitted by June 15th, of the current year, either electronically or mailed to the Youth Coordinator.

Regulations:

1. Youth members will write and research their essay independently.
2. Any references or resources will be cited.
3. Youth members will be active members in good standing at the time of submission of their essays.

Intermediate/Senior: How do you think the agriculture industry has been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic? Explain.”
